The new <u>Capital Access Program</u> will help Seattle-area applicants by paying down 25% of their loan principal for the <u>Small Business</u> <u>Flex Fund</u>,

Seattle businesses must apply to the Flex Fund by **April 8 at 5 pm** to be considered for payment support. Lenders will evaluate eligibility upon application.



Loan Amount: Up to \$150,000



Interest Rates: 4% for businesses



Repayment Period: 60-month (5 years)
